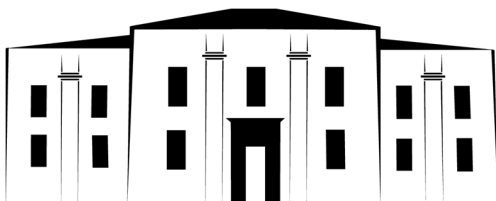

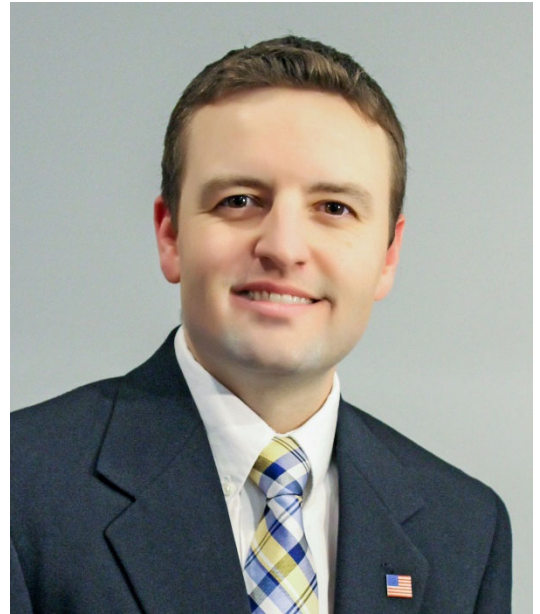

Dear Monroe County Voters,

The November 8, 2022 General Election is here. All Monroe County polling places will be open from 6:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. on election day. A list of active polling places can be found on page 7 of this election guide.

Early voting will also be available at the Monroe County Courthouse starting on September 29, 2022 thru November 7, 2022 from 8:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. Saturday voting will be on October 29 and November 5 from 9:00 a.m. until noon.

For voters who prefer to vote-by-mail, please submit your vote-by-mail application as soon as possible. You can download an application on my website at www.mococlerk.com. A print signature is required on your application (no e-signatures). Our election judges will do a signature check. If your signature has changed significantly, I recommend that you to vote in-person at the Courthouse and update your signature card.

If you request a vote-by-mail ballot, please do not hand deliver your ballot to your polling place on election day. Mailed ballots can only be returned directly to my office.

I understand that many people have concerns regarding voting by mail. I have concerns too. However, vote-by-mail laws can only be changed by the General Assembly. On a local level, I can assure you that I am taking extra precautions to make sure vote-by-mail is fair and transparent. I have also refrained from installing ballot drop boxes due to security concerns.

Last, I want to thank all of our election workers, and full-time staff, for their hard work and dedication to open, fair, and transparent elections. In the weeks leading up to the election, many of us work nights and weekends to make sure we stay on schedule to print ballots, program and test equipment, and prepare supplies for our election's judges. Thank you!

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT PROPOSALS

"NOTICE

THE FAILURE TO VOTE THIS BALLOT MAY BE THE EQUIVALENT OF A NEGATIVE VOTE, BECAUSE A CONVENTION SHALL BE CALLED OR THE AMENDMENT SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE IF APPROVED BY EITHER THREE-FIFTHS OF THOSE VOTING ON THE QUESTION OR A MAJORITY OF THOSE VOTING IN THE ELECTION. (THIS IS NOT TO BE CONSTRUED AS A DIRECTION THAT YOUR VOTE IS REQUIRED TO BE CAST EITHER IN FAVOR OF OR IN OPPOSITION TO THE PROPOSITION HEREIN CONTAINED.)

WHETHER YOU VOTE THIS BALLOT OR NOT YOU MUST RETURN IT TO THE ELECTION JUDGE WHEN YOU LEAVE THE VOTING BOOTH".

EXPLANATION OF AMENDMENT

The proposed amendment would add a new section to the Bill of Rights Article of the Illinois Constitution that would guarantee workers the fundamental right to organize and to bargain collectively and to negotiate wages, hours, and working conditions, and to promote their economic welfare and safety at work. The new amendment would also prohibit from being passed any new law that intereferes with, negates, or diminishes the right of employees to organize and bargain collectively over their wages, hours, and other terms and conditions of employment and workplace safety. At the general election to be held on November 8, 2022, you will be called upon to decide whether the proposed amendment should become part of the Illinois Constituition.

For the proposed addition of Section 25 to Article I of the Illinois Constitution.
